### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The Hawaii public housing authority shall
- 2 establish a two-year recreation and education upward mobility
- 3 pilot program for youth tenants in public housing. The pilot
- 4 program shall:

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- (1) Provide youth tenants with the opportunity toparticipate in sports; and
- 7 (2) Offer an educational component with courses or
  8 opportunities designed to increase financial literacy,
  9 provide job skills training, and offer volunteer
  10 opportunities that will enable youth tenants to gain
  11 knowledge and experience in preparation for college, a
- (b) The Hawaii public housing authority may enter into
  contracts with nonprofit organizations, for-profit
  organizations, or foundations to implement the recreation and
  education upward mobility pilot program for youth tenants in

business trade, or military enlistment.

- 3 (c) The Hawaii public housing authority shall submit:
- 4 (1) An interim report to the legislature on the status of
- 5 the pilot program no later than twenty days prior to

- 7 (2) A final report of its findings and recommendations,
- 8 including any proposed legislation, no later than
- 9 twenty days prior to the convening of the regular
- 10 session of 2026.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
- 14 the implementation of the recreation and education upward
- 15 mobility pilot program for youth tenants in public housing,
- 16 including all program costs.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii public
- 18 housing authority for the purposes of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 20 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
- 21 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the

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1	appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state
2	general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be

4	appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund

12	(1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
13	serve the public interest; and
14	(2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
15	addressed by this Act.
16	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
