In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of 8 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and 9 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined 10 that the appropriations contained in this Act will cause the 11 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 12 to be exceeded by \$, or per cent. The appropriations made for the capital 15 improvement project authorized by this part shall not lapse at 16 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriations are 17 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations 18 unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date. 19 PART III 20 SECTION 8. Description:

Lapses appropriations of general obligation bond funds previously authorized for the planning, design, and construction of a stadium in Halawa by the Stadium Authority. Transfers certain special fund moneys earmarked for the development of a new stadium in Halawa to the general fund. Reappropriates those funds to plan, design, and construct a new stadium at the University of Hawaii at Manoa campus. Renames the Stadium Authority as the Halawa Redevelopment Authority and the Stadium Development District as the Halawa Redevelopment District. Amends the powers and duties of the Halawa Redevelopment Authority. Declares that the appropriation exceeds the state general fund expenditure ceiling for 2024-2025.
