A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BURIAL SITES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is necessary to
- 2 reflect the seriousness of the act of disturbing human remains
- 3 from burial sites without consent.
- 4 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to increase the
- 5 penalty for the desecration of burial sites from a misdemeanor
- 6 to a felony to deter potential violators from harming burial
- 7 sites.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 6E-72, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 10 "(b) Taking, appropriation, excavation, injury,
- 11 destruction, or alteration of a burial site is a [misdemeanor]
- 12 felony for which a fine not to exceed \$25,000 [may] shall be
- 13 imposed, in addition to any other penalty authorized by chapter
- 14 706 for a [misdemeanor] felony."
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 17 begun before its effective date.
