A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AN ENVIRONMENTAL TOXINS LABORATORY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	'ION 1	. Chapter 342J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y add	ing a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:

7	(1)	Esta	blish and operate a laboratory capable of:
8		<u>(A)</u>	Testing for diseases;
9		(B)	Testing for the presence of toxins in samples of
10			air, water, soil, and biological and other
11			specimens; and
12		<u>(C)</u>	Conducting other high complexity testing; and
13	(2)	Ensu	re that the testing laboratory complies with all
14		appl	icable standards enumerated in the Clinical
15		Labo	ratories Improvement Amendments of 1988, title 42
16		Unit	ed States Code section 263a.

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(b) 1 The laboratory established pursuant to subsection (a) shall receive and analyze samples submitted by any person who 2 reasonably believes that the sample contains environmental 3 4 toxins in violation of applicable law. 5 (c) In operating the testing laboratory, the department shall ensure prompt and full public access to the results of 6 7 analyses of all submissions of testing samples submitted to the laboratory. The department shall provide complete reports of 8 9 all submissions no later than ten days after receipt of the 10 submissions." SECTION 2. The department may obtain and expend federal 11 **12** funds for the construction and operation of the testing 13 laboratory established pursuant to this Act. However, if the 14 school is unable to obtain firm commitment from the federal 15 government for the adequate financing of the laboratory within 16 nine months of the effective date of this Act, the department **17** shall proceed expeditiously to construct and begin initial operations of the laboratory using the funds appropriated by 18 19 this Act. 20 SECTION 3. The department shall submit a report on its

progress of establishing a laboratory pursuant to this Act, to

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- 1 the legislature no later than thirty days prior to the convening
- 2 of the regular session of 2025.
- 3 SECTION 4. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 4 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
- 6 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2024-2025
- 7 for the purpose of financing the construction of an
- 8 environmental toxins testing laboratory.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 10 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 5. The appropriation made for the capital
- 12 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
- 13 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
- 14 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
- 15 unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.
- 16 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
