A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 2 moneys to the university of Hawaii economic research
- 3 organization for a multiethnic cohort study on the effects of
- 4 the devastating 2023 Maui wildfires to provide the State, local
- 5 organizations, and future policymakers with critical information
- 6 and data needed to address imminent community needs, inform the
- 7 long-term recovery process, and support better planning for
- 8 future disaster preparedness.
- 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the
- 12 university of Hawaii economic research organization to conduct a
- 13 multiethnic cohort study on the effects of the 2023 Maui
- 14 wildfires.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the university of
- 16 Hawaii economic research organization for the purposes of this
- 17 Act.

1	SECTION 3. The university of Hawaii economic research
2	organization shall seek federal and community funding, in
3	addition to the funds appropriated by this Act, to complete the
4	multiethnic cohort study pursuant to section 3 of this Act.
5	SECTION 4. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of
6	the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
7	37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
8	that the appropriation contained in this Act will cause the
9	state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025
10	to be exceeded by or per cent. The reasons
11	for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that the
12	appropriation made in this Act is necessary to serve the public
13	interest and to meet the need provided for by this Act.
14	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
