A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate
2	moneys to the university of Hawaii for a multiethnic cohort
3	study and registry on the health effects of the devastating 2023
4	Maui wildfires. This Act is a matter of statewide concern as it
5	will provide the State, local organizations, and policymakers
6	with critical information and data needed to address imminent
7	community needs, inform the long-term recovery process, and
8	support better planning for future disaster preparedness.
9	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
10	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
11	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
12	the university of Hawaii economic research organization for the
13	following:
14	(1) \$ to conduct a multiethnic cohort study on
15	the health effects of the 2023 Maui wildfires; and
16	(2) \$ to develop and maintain of a registry of
17	those affected by the wildfires to assess their long-

1 term health and well-being and the impacts on 2 communities. 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the university of 4 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act. 5 SECTION 3. The university of Hawaii shall seek federal and community funding, in addition to the funds appropriated by this 6 7 Act, to complete the multiethnic cohort study and registry 8 pursuant to sections 2 of this Act. 9 SECTION 4. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and 10 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined 11 12 that the appropriation contained in this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 13 to be exceeded by 14 or per cent. The reasons for 15 exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that the 16 appropriation made in this Act is necessary to serve the public 17 interest and to meet the need provided for by this Act. 18 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
