## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds 2 to the university of Hawaii for a multiethnic cohort study and 3 registry on the health effects of the devastating August 2023 4 Maui wildfires. This Act is a matter of statewide concern 5 pursuant to article X, section 6, of the Hawaii State 6 Constitution, as it will provide the State, local organizations, 7 and policymakers with critical information and data needed to address imminent community needs, inform the long-term recovery 8 9 process, and support better planning for future disaster 10 preparedness.

11 SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of 12 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and 13 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined 14 that the appropriation contained in this Act will cause the 15 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 16 to be exceeded by per cent. The reasons for or 17 exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that the



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1	appropriation made in this Act is necessary to serve the public
2	interest and to meet the need provided for by this Act.
3	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
4	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
5	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
6	the university of Hawaii economic research organization, which
7	shall be allocated as follows:
8	(1) \$ to conduct a multiethnic cohort study on
9	the health effects of the August 2023 Maui wildfires;
10	and
11	(2) \$ to develop and maintain of a registry of
12	those affected by the wildfires to assess their long-
13	term health and well-being and the impacts on
14	communities.
15	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the university of
16	Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
17	SECTION 4. The university of Hawaii shall seek matching,
18	or more, federal and community funding, in addition to the funds
19	appropriated by this Act, to complete the multiethnic cohort
20	study and registry pursuant to section 3 of this Act.
21	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
