A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, as the demand for
- 2 unskilled labor increases, farmers and ranchers are searching
- 3 for ways to use technology to better operate their farms. The
- 4 legislature further finds that certain foreign technology, like
- 5 small equipment tractors from Japan, could be greatly beneficial
- 6 to farmers and ranchers. However, this type of equipment cannot
- 7 be imported because it does not comply with the United States
- 8 Environmental Protection Agency's emission standards for small
- 9 engines.
- 10 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to benefit farmers
- 11 and ranchers in the State by establishing and appropriating
- 12 funds for a foreign agriculture small equipment pilot program.
- 13 The pilot program shall be established at a university of Hawaii
- 14 community college selected by the university of Hawaii and
- 15 administered by the department of agriculture, in collaboration
- 16 with the university of Hawaii. The pilot program shall identify
- 17 and purchase foreign agricultural technology, including small

- 1 equipment tractors, and retrofit engines to comply with the
- 2 United States Environmental Protection Agency's emission
- 3 standards for small engines.
- 4 SECTION 2. The legislature finds that facilitating the
- 5 importation of foreign agriculture small equipment is a matter
- 6 of statewide concern.
- 7 SECTION 3. There is established the foreign agriculture
- 8 small equipment pilot program at a university of Hawaii
- 9 community college that shall be selected by the university of
- 10 Hawaii. The pilot program shall be administered by the
- 11 department of agriculture in collaboration with the university
- 12 of Hawaii. The pilot program shall identify and purchase
- 13 foreign agricultural technology, including small equipment
- 14 tractors, and retrofit engines to comply with the United States
- 15 Environmental Protection Agency's emission standards for small
- 16 engines.
- 17 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 19 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
- 20 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 21 year 2024-2025 to establish the foreign agriculture small

- 1 equipment pilot program at a university of Hawaii community
- 2 college selected by the university of Hawaii, to identify and
- 3 purchase foreign agricultural technology, including small
- 4 equipment tractors, and retrofit engines to comply with the
- 5 United States Environmental Protection Agency's emission
- 6 standards for small engines.
- 7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 8 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 5. The department of agriculture shall submit a
- 10 report of its findings and recommendations regarding the foreign
- 11 agriculture small equipment pilot program, including any
- 12 proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty
- 13 days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2024.
- 14 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
