A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMPENSATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that county police SECTION 1. 2 commissions, fire commissions, liquor commissions, and other 3 county boards, commissions, authorities, and committees having 4 oversight and supervisory powers are vital to county operations. 5 The legislature also finds that members of these entities are 6 unpaid, in spite of the hard work that they do. The legislature 7 believes that these professionals and experts should be provided 8 some level of compensation for their efforts. The legislature 9 also notes that there have been instances of fraud because 10 certain nefarious individuals were appointed to serve as members 11 of these entities, and used their positions in an unethical 12 manner. To prevent reoccurrence, the legislature finds that the 13 counties should offer reasonable compensation to attract 14 qualified, ethical candidates to serve in these positions. 15 The purpose of this Act is to:



1	(1)	Require each county to establish rates of compensation	
2		for members of certain qualifying county boards,

4	(2)	Require each county to submit a report to the	
5		legislature regarding the county's compliance with	
6		this Act; and	
7	(3)	Appropriate moneys to each county for the purpose of	
8		providing the State's share of the cost component	
9		associated with providing the compensation required by	
10		this Act.	
11	SECTION 2. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended		
12	by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately		
13	designated and to read as follows:		
14	" <u>\$46- Members of county boards; compensation.</u> (a) No		
15	later than , each county shall enact an		
16	ordinance, or the applicable political subdivision of the county		
17	shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91, with respect to the		
18	compensation of the members of qualifying county boards.		
19	Specifically, the ordinance or rules, among other requirements,		
20	prohibitions, or provisions that may be included by the county		
21	or its political subdivision, shall:

1	(1)	Establish that each member of a qualifying county
2		board appointed after shall be
3		compensated at:
4		(A) The per diem rate or other rate, if any, at which
5		members of federal boards, commissions,
6		authorities, or committees are typically
7		compensated; or
8		(B) A rate of \$ per hour,
9		whichever leads to a higher rate of pay per day; and
10	(2)	Address whether each qualifying member shall be
11		considered an employee of the respective county.
12	(b)	For the purposes of this section:
13	"Boa	rd" means any board, commission, authority, or
14	committee	of a county.
15	"Qua	lifying county board" means any board that is created
16	to have s	upervision, control, jurisdiction, or oversight power
17	over spec	ific matters and that is required to conduct meetings
18	and to ta	ke official actions. "Qualifying county board" does
19	not inclu	de any board that serves solely in an advisory
20	capacity,	or any county council."



SECTION 3. No later than twenty days prior to the 1 convening of the regular session of 2024, the mayor of each 2 county shall submit to the legislature a report of the status of 3 4 the county's compliance with this Act. 5 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 6 or so much 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 8 2024-2025 for the purpose of providing the State's share of the 9 cost component associated with providing the compensation to 10 members of qualifying county boards required pursuant to this 11 12 Act. 13 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the city and 14 county of Honolulu for the purposes of this Act. 15 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the 17 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 18 2024-2025 for the purpose of providing the State's share of the 19 cost component associated with providing the compensation to 20

3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the county of
4 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the 7 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 8 9 2024-2025 for the purpose of providing the State's share of the 10 cost component associated with providing the compensation to members of qualifying county boards required pursuant to this 11 12 Act.

13 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the county of14 Maui for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the general 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the 18 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 19 2024-2025 for the purpose of providing the State's share of the 20 cost component associated with providing the compensation to

3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the county of4 Kauai for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
