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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to reclassify the  
2 human resources development special fund of the department of  
3 human resources development as a revolving fund, pursuant to the  
4 recommendation made by the auditor in auditor's report  
5 no. 22-12.

6           SECTION 2. Section 26-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
7 amended by amending subsection (g) to read as follows:

8           "(g) There is established in the state treasury the human  
9 resources development [~~special~~] revolving fund, to be  
10 administered by the department of human resources development,  
11 which shall consist of: all revenues received by the department  
12 as a result of entrepreneurial efforts in securing new sources  
13 of funds not provided for in the department's budget for  
14 services rendered by the department, all revenues received by  
15 the department from the charging of participant fees for  
16 in-service training that are in addition to general fund  
17 appropriations in the department's budget for developing and



1 operating in-service training programs, appropriations made by  
2 the legislature to the fund, and moneys directed to the  
3 department from any other source, including gifts, grants, and  
4 awards.

5 Moneys in the human resources development [~~special~~]  
6 revolving fund shall be used for the following purposes:

- 7 (1) Supporting the department's entrepreneurial  
8 initiatives, training activities, and programs;
- 9 (2) Administrative costs of the department's  
10 entrepreneurial initiatives, training activities, and  
11 programs; and
- 12 (3) Any other purpose deemed necessary by the director for  
13 the purpose of facilitating the department's  
14 entrepreneurial initiatives, training activities, and  
15 programs."

16 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
