BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART III 2 SECTION 3. Act 285, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, is 3 amended by amending section 2 to read as follows: 4 "SECTION 2. (a) No later than June 30, $\left[\frac{2023}{7}\right]$ 2024, the 5 Daniel K. Akaka state veterans home on Oahu shall be assimilated 6 into the Oahu regional health care system in a manner and to an 7 extent that may be negotiated between the Oahu regional health 8 care system and the department of defense. After assimilation, 9 the physical assets and the ground lease of the Daniel K. Akaka 10 state veterans home shall become the property of the Oahu regional health care system and the Daniel K. Akaka state 11 12 veterans home shall be managed by the Oahu regional health care 13 system. 14 (b) None of the liabilities of the Daniel K. Akaka state 15 veterans home in existence at the time the Daniel K. Akaka state 16 veterans home is assimilated into the Oahu regional health care 17 system shall become liabilities of the Oahu regional health care 18 system. 19 The Oahu regional health care system and the 20 department of defense shall submit a joint report on the

Extends the deadline to assimilate the Daniel K. Akaka State Veterans Home from the Department of Defense to the Oahu Regional Health Care System to 6/30/2024. Requires the Oahu Regional Health Care System and the Department of Defense to provide a joint progress report to the Legislature regarding construction of, and the hiring of an operator for, the Daniel K. Akaka State Veterans Home. Appropriates funds for the capital improvement project to construct a transitional treatment and housing facility on the Leahi Hospital campus. Effective 6/30/2050. (SD2)
