

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO YOUTH PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the office of youth
- 2 services of the department of human services provides and
- 3 coordinates a continuum of services and programs for at-risk
- 4 youth to prevent delinquency and reduce the incidence of
- 5 recidivism. The office of youth services has four main support
- 6 programs: juvenile justice in Hawaii, which aims to prevent
- 7 delinquency and reduce the incidence of recidivism for youth-at-
- 8 risk; the Hawaii youth correctional facility, which is a
- 9 thirty-bed facility where the primary purpose is to provide care
- 10 and custody of at-risk youth committed to the State by the
- 11 family courts; the Hawaii juvenile justice state advisory
- 12 council, which advises government and local communities on
- 13 effective service provisions and policies that improve the
- 14 juvenile justice system and advocates for delinquency
- 15 prevention; and the Hawaii state youth commission, which advises
- 16 the governor and legislature on the effects of legislative

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- 1 policies, needs, assessments, priorities, programs, and budgets
- 2 concerning the youth of the State.
- 3 The legislature further finds that in light of youth
- 4 suicide rates, dropout rates, and interactions with the criminal
- 5 justice system, especially for youth originating from the
- 6 Pacific islands, the youth of Hawaii would benefit from the
- 7 myriad of Pacific youth programs offered to assist at-risk
- 8 youth. Recognizing the unique needs of individuals from the
- 9 Pacific and the other parts of Oceania, the university of Hawaii
- 10 has a student services specialist dedicated to provide student
- 11 support services for students from Oceania.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to establish a Pacific youth
- 13 programs coordinator position within the office of youth
- 14 services.
- 15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the
- 18 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 19 2024-2025 for one permanent full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE)
- 20 Pacific youth program coordinator position within the office of
- 21 youth services of the department of human services.

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- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- 2 youth services for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
