A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE I OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF HAWAII TO RECOGNIZE AND PROTECT THE INHERENT AND INALIENABLE RIGHT OF ALL PEOPLE TO CLEAN WATER AND AIR, A HEALTHFUL ENVIRONMENT AND CLIMATE, HEALTHY NATIVE ECOSYSTEMS, AND BEACHES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
- 2 amendment to article I of the Constitution of the State of
- 3 Hawaii to establish the constitutional right of the people to
- 4 clean water and air, a healthful environment and climate,
- 5 healthy native ecosystems, and beaches, which shall be protected
- 6 and shall not be infringed.
- 7 This proposed amendment reflects the rooted traditions and
- 8 collective cultural conscience of the State's people and
- 9 exemplifies the fundamental native Hawaiian notion of aloha
- 10 aina, which translates to "love of the land" and is central to
- 11 native Hawaiian values and beliefs. The proposed amendment will
- 12 also complement existing constitutional provisions and reinforce
- 13 protections of human health, natural and cultural values, and
- 14 the environment, all of which are essential to the sustenance of

- 1 the State as well as the intrinsic beauty of its islands that
- 2 attract admiration from peoples all over the world.
- 3 SECTION 2. Article I of the Constitution of the State of
- 4 Hawaii is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
- 5 designated and to read as follows:
- 6 "ENVIRONMENTAL RIGHTS
- 7 **Section** . The inherent and inalienable rights of the
- 8 people, including present and future generations, to clean water
- 9 and air, a healthful environment and climate, healthy native
- 10 ecosystems and beaches shall be protected and shall not be
- infringed."
- 12 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
- 13 be as follows:
- "Shall the Constitution of the State of Hawaii be amended
- 15 to establish that the inherent and inalienable right of the
- people, including present and future generations, to clean
- water and air, a healthful environment and climate, healthy
- native ecosystems and beaches shall be protected and shall
- not be infringed?"
- 20 SECTION 4. New constitutional material is underscored.

- 1 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000;
- 2 provided that this amendment shall take effect upon compliance
- 3 with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of the State
- 4 of Hawaii.
