# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXCESSIVE NOISE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. (a) The department of transportation, in  
2 conjunction with the appropriate counties, shall develop a pilot  
3 program to use noise detection traffic cameras to address  
4 excessive traffic noise in urban areas in counties with a  
5 population of more than five hundred thousand.

6           (b) The department of transportation shall submit a report  
7 of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed  
8 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior  
9 to the convening of the regular session of 2025.

10          SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$                    or so  
12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and  
13 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
14 year 2024-2025 for the purposes of this Act.

15          The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department  
16 of transportation for the purposes of this Act.



1           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000,  
2 and be repealed on December 31, 2025.

Requires report to the legislature. Sunsets 12/31/2025. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD1)
