A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RAW MILK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I
2	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many people would
3	like to consume raw, unpasteurized milk and raw milk products
4	based on the products' health benefits and taste. Some studies
5	have shown that raw milk helps reduce allergies, boost immunity
6	hydrate skin, and address nutritional deficiencies. Raw milk
7	has a unique flavor that may be destroyed by the double
8	pasteurization process generally required for commercial milk
9	sales. It also contains bacteria that are essential flavor
10	components for some cheeses.
11	The legislature recognizes that raw milk can be produced
12	safely and that its sale is permitted in many states. At least
13	twelve states allow the sale of raw milk in retail stores. Two
14	states permit it to be sold at farmers markets, and at least
15	twelve states allow farmers to sell raw milk directly to
16	consumers. The legislature believes Hawaii's consumers also

- 1 deserve this freedom of choice and should be permitted to
- 2 purchase raw milk and raw milk products directly from farmers.
- 3 Accordingly, the purpose of this part is to allow milk
- 4 producers to sell raw milk and raw milk products directly to
- 5 consumers, with certain conditions.
- 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 157, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 8 and to read as follows:
- 9 "<u>\$157-</u> Raw milk and raw milk products; direct sales.
- 10 (a) Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, a producer
- 11 may sell raw milk and raw milk products directly to consumers
- 12 for human consumption, subject to rules adopted by the board
- 13 pursuant to subsection (b); provided that the farm or facility
- 14 from which the raw milk or raw milk product originated shall own
- or house no more than ten milk-bearing cows.
- 16 (b) No later than July 1, 2024, the board shall adopt
- 17 rules pursuant to chapter 91 governing the direct sale to
- 18 consumers of raw milk and raw milk products for human
- 19 consumption. The rules shall:

1	(1)	Include conditions similar to those found in the
2		administrative rules of other states that allow the
3		sale of raw milk and raw milk products;
4	(2)	Establish standards to ensure that raw milk and raw
5		milk products are not contaminated during production
6		or sale; and
7	(3)	Regulate any circumstances under which producers may
8		share cows for the purposes of producing raw milk or
9		raw milk products.
10	<u>(c)</u>	Each container of raw milk or raw milk product
11	intended	for sale shall include on the container or packaging:
12	(1)	A label reading "RAW MILK", "RAW MILK PRODUCT", or
13		"CONTAINS RAW MILK PRODUCTS", as applicable; and
14	(2)	A statement reading "Contains pathogens that may be
15		unsafe to consume".
16	SECT	ION 3. Section 157-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17	amended b	y adding two new definitions to be appropriately
18	inserted	and to read as follows:
19	" <u>"</u> Ra	w milk" means milk that has not been pasteurized or
20	otherwise	treated with heat.

         SECTION 4. Section 157-21, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

    amended to read as follows:

         "§157-21 Licensing. [It] Except as provided in section

    producer-distributor, or distributor to produce, sell, process,

    or distribute milk in a milk shed unless the person is duly

    licensed as provided by this chapter. It shall be unlawful for

    any such person to sell, buy, process, or distribute milk

    [which] that the person knows or has reason to believe has been

    produced or handled in violation of this chapter."

         SECTION 5. Section 157-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
    amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

(d) For the purposes of this section:		
"Goat milk" means the lacteal secretion, practically free		
from colostrum, obtained by the complete milking of healthy		
goats.		
"Raw goat milk" means goat milk that has not been		
pasteurized or otherwise treated with heat."
