A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of
- 2 human resources development is committed to making the State a
- 3 desirable place to work and supporting the approximately
- 4 fourteen thousand employees who work throughout the State.
- 5 The legislature also finds that the department of human
- 6 resources development's information technology systems require
- 7 additional investment and modernization. Specifically, by
- 8 upgrading or replacing equipment, hiring key information
- 9 technology personnel, upgrading the existing outdated network
- 10 infrastructure, and providing necessary training, the department
- 11 of human resources development will be able to hire new,
- 12 essential state workers more quickly and provide the department
- 13 with the assets it needs to function more efficiently overall.
- 14 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
