A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIBRARIES AT PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that schools with a
- 2 strong school library program and a certified school librarian
- 3 provide their students with the best chance to succeed. The
- 4 legislature further finds that more than sixty education and
- 5 library research studies have produced clear evidence that
- 6 school library programs staffed by qualified school librarians
- 7 have a positive impact on students' academic achievement. These
- 8 studies also clearly demonstrate that strong school library
- 9 programs help all students do better academically, even when
- 10 other school variables are considered. The legislature
- 11 additionally finds that multiple studies over the last two
- 12 decades have shown that having trained librarians in schools
- 13 improves students' test scores, increases student participation
- 14 in libraries, and can contribute to having larger and newer book
- 15 collections.
- 16 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to:

1	(1) Require a qualified school librarian and library
2	resources on the campus of every public school in
3	Hawaii; and
4	(2) Appropriate funds for these purposes.
5	SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
7	and to read as follows:
8	"§302A- School librarians; library resources. (a) No
9	later than June 30, 2026, every public school in the State shall
10	have access to a qualified school librarian and library
11	resources on the campus of the school.
12	(b) As used in this section:
13	"Library resources" means any informational resource or
14	material, regardless of format, that includes books,
15	periodicals, audio and video recordings, projected media,
16	closed-format materials, artwork, photographs, micro-materials,
17	toys and games, computer software, and electronic databases.
18	"Qualified librarian" means a certified teacher who also
19	hold a master's degree in library science."
20	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
21	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so

- 1 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
- 2 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 3 year 2024-2025 to provide a qualified librarian and library
- 4 resources on the campus of every public school in the State.
- 5 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 6 of education for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 9 provided that section 3 shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
