

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FORTY-SIXTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$20,700,000 or so much
3	thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4	as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024
5	for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-
6	sixth representative district, as follows:
7	1. Kaʻala elementary school
8	Design and construction for electrical
9	upgrades to accommodate technology and
10	innovation needs.
11	Design \$500,000
12	Construction \$4,500,000
13	Total funding \$5,000,000
14	The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
15	shall be expended by the department of education.
16	2. Ka'ala elementary school



1	Design, construction, and equipment and
2	appurtenances for a covered playcourt
3	for year-round student fitness.
4	Design \$550,000
5	Construction \$3,500,000
6	Equipment \$250,000
7	Total funding \$4,300,000
8	The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
9	shall be expended by the department of education.
10	3. Wahiawa elementary school
11	Design and construction for electrical
12	upgrades to accommodate air-
13	conditioning systems and technology
14	innovation equipment.
15	Design \$100,000
16	Construction \$1,000,000
17	Total funding \$1,100,000
18	The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
19	shall be expended by the department of education.
20	4. Wahiawa elementary school

SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.
SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
