## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the med-QUEST
- 2 division of the department of human services offers standard
- 3 behavioral health services to all medicaid beneficiaries. In
- 4 addition, individuals with serious mental illness or serious and
- 5 persistent mental illness receive additional specialized
- 6 behavioral health services through their QUEST health plans.
- 7 However, the legislature also finds that various behavioral
- 8 health services are not currently covered under med-QUEST or are
- 9 covered at rates that are below market reimbursement rates,
- 10 resulting in provider network adequacy and access to care
- 11 issues.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 13 funds to the med-QUEST division of the department of human
- 14 services for non-covered or under-covered behavioral health
- 15 services for med-QUEST beneficiaries.
- 16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so



- f 1 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
- 2 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 3 year 2024-2025 for the med-QUEST division of the department of
- 4 human services, program identification number HMS401 (health
- 5 care payments), for non-covered or under-covered behavioral
- 6 health services for med-OUEST beneficiaries.
- 7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- $oldsymbol{8}$  of human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 30, 3000.
