#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 12 further that vacancies on the board for each trustee position
- 13 representing retirees and employee-beneficiaries appointed under
- 14 section  $87A-5(1)(A) \left[\frac{and}{f}\right]_{,}$  (B), and (C) shall be filled by
- 15 appointment of the governor as follows:
- 16 (1) If a vacancy occurs in one of the trustee positions
