# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The University of Hawaii Maui college's office
- 2 of international and regional partnerships connects students
- 3 from Maui and abroad to develop meaningful relationships in an
- 4 increasingly globalized world. The office offers study abroad
- 5 opportunities in Canada, the Czech Republic, Japan, South Korea,
- 6 New Zealand, Okinawa, the Philippines, Portugal, and Spain.
- 7 Studying abroad helps students gain foreign language skills and
- 8 cross-cultural competence. The office of international and
- 9 regional partnerships also works with the Maui County Sister
- 10 Cities Foundation to promote economic and educational
- 11 relationships between the county of Maui and the world. The
- 12 office of international and regional partnerships estimates that
- 13 \$ is needed to allow eighteen to twenty students to
- 14 participate in study abroad programs, based on past travel
- 15 costs.
- 16 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 17 funds for the University of Hawaii Maui college's office of

- 1 international and regional partnerships to subsidize travel
- 2 expenses and tuition for students to study abroad.
- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
- 6 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 7 year 2024-2025 for the study abroad programs offered by the
- 8 University of Hawaii Maui college's office of international and
- 9 regional partnerships.
- 10 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University
- 11 of Hawaii Maui college for the purposes of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
