## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LAND CONSERVATION FUND.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 247-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§247-7 Disposition of taxes. All taxes collected under 4 this chapter shall be paid into the state treasury to the credit 5 of the general fund of the State, to be used and expended for 6 the purposes for which the general fund was created and exists 7 by law; provided that of the taxes collected each fiscal year: 8 Ten per cent or [\$5,100,000,] \$9,800,000, whichever is (1) 9 less, shall be paid into the land conservation fund 10 established pursuant to section 173A-5; and 11 (2) Fifty per cent or \$38,000,000, whichever is less, 12 shall be paid into the rental housing revolving fund 13 established by section 201H-202." 14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
