A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII STATE BUILDING CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 107-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

3 "§107-28 County authority to amend and adopt the Hawaii 4 state building codes without council approval. (a) The 5 governing body of each county shall amend, adopt, and update the 6 Hawaii state building codes as they apply within their 7 respective jurisdiction, in accordance with section 46-1.5(13), 8 unless otherwise provided for in this section, and without 9 approval of the council. Each county shall amend and adopt the 10 Hawaii state building codes and standards listed in section 107-11 25, as the referenced Hawaii state building codes and standards 12 for its respective county building code ordinance, no later than two years after the adoption of the Hawaii state building codes. 13 14 (b) If a county does not amend the Hawaii state building 15 codes within the two-year time frame, the Hawaii state building 16 codes shall become applicable as an interim county building 17 code.

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1	(c) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, a county may
2	adopt a county building code that is distinct from the Hawaii
3	state building codes and applicable only to single-family
4	dwellings, additional dwelling units, duplexes, and non-
5	commercial structures that have no more than square
6	feet of living area."
7	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
8	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000;
9	provided that on June 30, 2026, this Act shall be repealed and
10	section 107-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in
11	the form in which it read on the day before the effective date
12	of this Act.
