

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO A STATE CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding	a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3	read as fo	ollows:
4	" <u>§</u> 26-	State chief operating officer; established. (a)
5	The gover	nor shall appoint, and may remove, a state chief
6	operating	officer, without regard to chapter 76.
7	(b)	The state chief operating officer shall:
8	(1)	Be experienced in the operations of government,
9		business, and economic development;
10	(2)	Assist the governor by developing and recommending
11		policies and programs beneficial to businesses and to
12		increase economic development; and
13	(3)	Coordinate the policies of the governor regarding
14		business and economic development with the department
15		of business, economic development, and tourism.
16	<u>(c)</u>	The state chief operating officer shall be a member of
17	the state	employees' retirement system and shall be included

- 1 under any other state or federal employee benefit program
- 2 generally applicable to officers and employees of the State."
- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the
- 6 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 7 2024-2025 for one full time equivalent (1.0 FTE) state chief
- 8 operating officer.
- 9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- 10 the governor for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
