A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 to be
4	deposited into the rental housing revolving fund established by
5	section 201H-202, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
6	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the rental housing
7	revolving fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may
8	be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 to carry out the purposes
9	of the rental housing revolving fund; provided that up to
10	\$ may be used for mixed-income rental projects or
11	units in mixed-income rental projects targeted for individuals
12	and families having incomes above sixty per cent and at or below
13	one hundred per cent of the median family income for the State
14	of Hawaii; provided further that any unexpended or unencumbered
15	balance of the appropriation made by this Act as of June 30,
16	2025, may be used for other rental housing projects pursuant to
17	section 201H-202(e)(1)(A) and (B), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

- 3 this Act; provided that the appropriation shall not lapse at the
