A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRIBUTIONS BY STATE AND COUNTY CONTRACTORS AND GRANTEES OF THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-355, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]\$11-355[+] Contributions by state and county
- 4 contractors, and grantees of the State; prohibited. (a) It
- 5 shall be unlawful for any person who enters into any contract
- 6 with the State, any of the counties, or any department or agency
- 7 thereof either for the rendition of personal services, the
- 8 buying of property, or furnishing of any material, supplies, or
- 9 equipment to the State, any of the counties, any department or
- 10 agency thereof, or for selling any land or building to the
- 11 State, any of the counties, or any department or agency thereof,
- 12 if payment for the performance of the contract or payment for
- 13 material, supplies, equipment, land, property, or building is to
- 14 be made in whole or in part from funds appropriated by the
- 15 legislative body, at any time between the execution of the
- 16 contract through the completion of the contract, to:

- 1 contractor, or grantee of the State, and their immediate family
- 2 members, are prohibited from directly or indirectly making any
- 3 contribution to a candidate committee or noncandidate committee.
- 4 [\(\frac{(b)}{}\)] (d) Except as provided in [\(\frac{\text{subsection}}{}\)] subsections
- 5 (a), (b), and (c), this section does not prohibit or make
- 6 unlawful the establishment or administration of, or the
- 7 solicitation of contributions to, any noncandidate committee by
- 8 any person other than the state or county contractor, or grantee
- 9 of the State, or their officers, employees, and immediate family
- 10 members, for the purpose of influencing the nomination for
- 11 election, or the election of any person to office.
- [(e)] (e) For purposes of this section, "completion of the
- 13 contract" means that the parties to the government contract have
- 14 either terminated the contract prior to completion of
- 15 performance or fully performed the duties and obligations under
- 16 the contract, no disputes relating to the performance and
- 17 payment remain under the contract, and all disputed claims have
- 18 been adjudicated and are final."
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 20 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 21 begun before its effective date.
