WHEREAS, the State is experiencing an acute mental health 1 2 crisis among children and youth; and 3 4 WHEREAS, school psychologists provide direct and indirect support to evaluate and address students' intellectual 5 development, academic success, social-emotional learning, and 6 7 mental and behavioral health; and 8 9 WHEREAS, school counselors counsel students and parents, evaluate students' abilities, address learning problems, and 10 11 assist students in career and personal development; and 12 WHEREAS, school psychologists and school counselors are 13 14 crucial to supporting the mental health and well-being of students in school; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, the National Association of School Psychologists recommends a ratio of one psychologist to five hundred students; 18 19 and 20 21 WHEREAS, the American School Counselor Association recommends a ratio of one school counselor to two hundred fifty 22 23 students; and 24 25 WHEREAS, public schools and public charter schools in the 26 State presently do not meet the recommendations by the National Association of School Psychologists; and 27 28
