
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

13 14	WHEREAS, according to the Honolulu Police Department's crime mapping, since October 1, 2023, there were three assaults,		
14	one sex crime, one weapons crime, and two thefts in the same		
16	location where the sixty-six year old man was attacked; and

19	would help to deter crime and increase safety in the area for
