## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO CONSIDER INCLUDING AN ANALYSIS OF SCOPE 1, 2, AND 3 GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS INTO ITS WORK TO TRACK GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS AND ITS NEXT GREENHOUSE GAS INVENTORY REPORT.

WHEREAS, the State recognizes the urgent need to address 1 climate change and reduce greenhouse gas emissions to protect 2 the environment and public health; and 3 4 WHEREAS, comprehensive greenhouse gas emissions reporting 5 6 is essential to understanding the sources and trends of carbon 7 emissions to inform effective mitigation strategies; and 8 9 WHEREAS, scope 1 greenhouse gas emissions encompass direct emissions from sources owned or controlled by the reporting 10 entity; and 11 12 WHEREAS, scope 2 greenhouse gas emissions encompass 13 14 indirect emissions from the generation of purchased electricity, heat, or steam consumed by a reporting entity; and 15 16 WHEREAS, scope 3 greenhouse gas emissions encompass 17 indirect emissions along the value chain, such as emissions 18 19 produced by travel and consumer activity; and 20 21 WHEREAS, effectively measuring scope 1, 2, and 3 greenhouse gas emissions is essential to developing a comprehensive 22 understanding of greenhouse gas emissions; and 23 24 WHEREAS, assessing and reporting scope 1, 2, and 3 25 greenhouse gas emissions are also crucial to identifying 26 27 opportunities for emissions reduction across public and private sectors and promoting sustainable practices throughout the 28 29 State; and



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1 2 WHEREAS, establishing transparent methods for scope 1, 2, and 3 greenhouse gas emissions reporting is crucial to ensuring 3 consistency, accuracy, and comparability of greenhouse gas 4 5 emissions data across governmental and nongovernmental sectors; 6 and 7 8 WHEREAS, identifying transparent methods for reporting on scope 1, 2, and 3 greenhouse gas emissions will provide 9 policymakers, businesses, and the public with valuable 10 information to support informed decision-making about climate 11 change mitigation efforts and the advancement of the State's 12 13 net-zero goals; now, therefore, 14 15 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 16 17 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 18 Health is requested to: 19 Consider including an analysis of scope 1, 2, and 3 20 (1)21 greenhouse gas emissions into its work to track 22 greenhouse gas emissions pursuant to section 342B-71, 23 Hawaii Revised Statutes; and 24 25 (2) Include the analysis in its next greenhouse gas 26 emissions inventory report to be submitted pursuant to 27 section 342B-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, if the 28 analysis is included in its work to track greenhouse 29 gas emissions; and 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 31 32 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Director of Health, and Director of the Hawaii State 33 Energy Office. 34



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
