HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A PERFORMANCE AUDIT OF THE OPERATIONS AND MANAGEMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES' DIVISION OF BOATING AND OCEAN RECREATION.

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources'
2 Division of Boating and Ocean Recreation (Division) manages the
3 State's small boat harbors, mooring and boating facilities, and
4 statewide ocean recreation programs; and

6 WHEREAS, the Division's responsibilities include enforcing
7 laws and rules pertaining to boating safety and regulation of

7 laws and rules pertaining to boating safety and regulation of 8 commercial activities and overseeing permits for ocean 9 recreation events, such as yacht races, canoe regattas, and 10 surfing contests; and

WHEREAS, in recent years, community members have expressed numerous concerns about the Division, particularly its lack of effective communication with the boating community, an inconsistent approach to interpreting and enforcing administrative rules, repeated and prolific complaints across the State about Division management, and ongoing issues of employee misconduct complaints and ethics violations; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Auditor previously conducted a management audit of state boating facilities operations from July 1, 1998, to June 30, 2000, and in April 2001 issued Report No. 01-09, "Audit of the Management of State Boating Facilities by the Department of Land and Natural Resources"; and

26 WHEREAS, the report found that mismanagement of state
27 boating facilities has been a recurring problem and recommended
28 that the Division develop strategic plans to address these
29 ongoing issues with the boating program; and

1 2 WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the Auditor to conduct a performance audit of the current operations and 3 4 management of the Division, considering the public's and the Auditor's long-standing concerns; now, therefore, 5 6 7 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 8 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the Auditor is 9 10 requested to conduct a performance audit of the operations and 11 management of the Department of Land and Natural Resources' 12 Division of Boating and Ocean Recreation; and 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 14 examine and include in its report whether the Division is using 15 government resources in compliance with statutes, rules, and 16 policies; whether the Division's activities are achieving their 17 18 objectives; and whether those activities are being conducted effectively, efficiently, economically, ethically, and 19 20 equitably; and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 23 submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including 24 any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 25 26 2025; and 27 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 29 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor and 30 Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources. 31 OFFERED BY: Viise E.
