HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM TO CONVENE A SPORTS WAGERING WORKING GROUP TO CONDUCT AN ANALYSIS OF THE POTENTIAL LEGALIZATION AND REGULATION OF ONLINE SPORTS WAGERING IN HAWAII.

WHEREAS, a robust illegal sports betting market thrives in 1 2 the absence of a legal, regulated framework; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the American Gaming Association estimates that 5 Americans wager over \$63,000,000,000 each year in the illegal market with no oversight, consumer protections, or tax revenue 6 7 generated; and 8 9 WHEREAS, sports wagering is offered safely and responsibly 10 by reputable operators in jurisdictions where sports wagering is legal, and these operators implement robust measures with regard 11 12 to identity verification, consumer protection, responsible gaming, and game integrity that are not present in the illegal 13 market; and 14 15 16 WHEREAS, by channeling this activity into a legal market and building a robust, responsible, and regulated market for 17 sports wagering, Hawaii stands to gain millions of dollars each 18 19 year in additional tax revenue; and 20 21 WHEREAS, the legalization of sports wagering presents an 22 opportunity to generate significant revenue for Hawaii; now, 23 therefore, 24 25 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 26 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 27 28 Business, Economic Development, and Tourism is requested to 29 convene a Sports Wagering Working Group to conduct an analysis
