HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT AN AUDIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION'S STATEWIDE BACKLOG OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE PROJECTS.

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Education is responsible for the repair and maintenance of 4,425 buildings statewide, which is 2 more than twenty million square feet of space; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, this is a time-consuming and financially-draining 6 task as approximately twenty percent of Hawaii's two hundred fifty-seven public schools are more than one hundred years old, 7 8 and the average age of school buildings in the State is seventy-9 two years; and 10 WHEREAS, properly repairing and maintaining public school 11 buildings is necessary for the safety of Hawaii's students and 12 13 teachers; and 14 15 WHEREAS, in January 2018, the Department of Education reported to the Legislature that the school repair and 16 maintenance backlog was \$293,000,000; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, however, the Department of Education later 20 redacted that statement, reporting that the true backlog was \$868,000,000; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, this backlog has sharply increased in the few past years and is now estimated to be more than \$1,400,000,000, with 24 25 more than four thousand six hundred repair and maintenance projects needed to be undertaken or finished by the Department 26 27 of Education; and 28 29 WHEREAS, because many public school facilities in the State are in need of repair or renovation, this body finds that it is 30 necessary to increase transparency and fiscal discipline by the 31 Department of Education; and 32

1 WHEREAS, an audit of the Department of Education could help 2 3 identify any shortcomings in the current distribution of funds and determine any necessary changes to increase the efficiency 4 5 of the Department of Education's capital improvement repair and 6 maintenance projects; now, therefore, 7 8 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 9 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, that the Auditor is requested to conduct an 10 audit of the Department of Education's statewide backlog of 11 capital improvement repair and maintenance projects; and 12 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 14 15 include projects relating to the renovation of central, 16 district, and program offices in the audit; and 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 18 19 submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including 20 any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 21 22 2025; and 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 24 25 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of Education, Superintendent of Education, and Auditor. 26 27 28 nigh the Chick 29 OFFERED BY:
