HOUSE RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING A WORKING GROUP TO ADDRESS ISSUES RELATED TO WATER AND AIR CONTAMINATION AND REMEDIATION ARISING FROM THE OPERATION OF THE PUULOA RANGE TRAINING FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the Puuloa Range Training Facility, located in Ewa 1 Beach on Oahu, is a shooting range that has been used by United 2 3 States Marine Corps for more than a century; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Ewa Beach community has grown around it, and the training facility now sits in the middle of a residential 6 7 neighborhood; and 8 9 WHEREAS, in conducting live-fire exercises, shooters fire into impact berms, including berms that front the ocean and 10 11 share a coastline with the area's beach parks; and 12 WHEREAS, lead contamination from shooting ranges can 13 accumulate in the soil and remain there for hundreds of years; 14 15 and 16 WHEREAS, in 2022, sampling done by the Surfrider Foundation 17 18 of soil samples taken from the beach side of the training facility identified high levels of lead; and 19 20 WHEREAS, there is a concern that lead from the soil at the 21 Puuloa Range Training Facility will leach into the ocean, 22 creating a serious risk to marine life in the area; and 23 24 WHEREAS, there is further concern that dust from lead-25 contaminated soil will enter the atmosphere and migrate into 26 residential neighborhoods via air or stormwater; and 27 28 WHEREAS, addressing this issue will require the input from 29 30 experts and community stakeholders; and 31

1 WHEREAS, this body finds that the threat to the health and safety of the residents of the Ewa Beach community constitutes 2 an emergency that requires immediate and decisive action; now, 3 4 therefore, 5 6 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 7 Session of 2024, that a working group be established to address 8 9 issues related to water and air contamination and remediation 10 arising from the operation of the Puuloa Range Training Facility; and 11 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested 13 14 to consist of the following members: 15 The Representative of House District 40; 16 (1)17 (2) The Councilmember for District 9 of the City and 18 19 County of Honolulu; and 20 (3)The Vice Chair of the Ewa Neighborhood Board No. 23; 21 22 and 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested 25 to invite other individuals with relevant experience and expertise to be members of the working group, including: 26 27 A marine biologist from the University of Hawaii at 28 (1)29 Manoa; 30 A representative from Kuleana Coral Restoration; (2)31 32 (3) A representative the fishing industry; 33 34 (4)A representative from the United States Marine Corps; 35 and 36 37 Any other members the working group deems necessary; (5)38 39 and 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested 41 to conduct informational briefings on issues related to water 42

and air contamination and remediation from the operation of the 1 Puuloa Range Training Facility and to take any other action as 2 the working group deems appropriate; and 3 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested 5 to meet on a quarterly basis; and 6 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested 8 to provide a quarterly report to the House of Representatives; 9 10 and 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group shall cease 12 on June 30, 2025; and 13 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 15 Resolution be transmitted to the Commander of the Marine Corps 16 17 Base Hawaii, Chancellor of the University of Hawaii at Manoa, Councilmember for District 9 of the City and County of Honolulu, 18 Vice Chair of Ewa Neighborhood Board No. 23, and Executive 19 Director of Kuleana Coral Restoration. 20 21 22 23 OFFERED BY:
