## HOUSE RESOLUTION

AMENDING THE RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO REQUIRE EACH MEMBER TO PLANT AT LEAST ONE FOOD TREE ON STATE LAND.

WHEREAS, the Hawaii State Planning Act establishes the 1 objective of expanding the State's agricultural base by 2 promoting the growth of various agricultural crops and products 3 and increasing Hawaii's agricultural self-sufficiency; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Hawaii State Planning Act also encourages the 6 increased purchase and use of Hawaii-grown food and food 7 products; and 8 9 WHEREAS, food trees, which are trees that are cultivated or 10 managed for their edible products, are crucial to meeting these 11 objectives; and 12 13 WHEREAS, each food tree planted is a step toward enhancing 14 Hawaii's food security goals; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the planting of food trees on state lands can help 17 to increase the productive and efficient use of those lands; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Hawaii's elected leaders can set an example for 20 others by actively participating in initiatives that promote 21 locally sourced, sustainable food production; and 22 23 WHEREAS, as a starting point, each member of this body 24 should plant at least one food tree on state land, now, 25 therefore, 26 27 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 28 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 29 Session of 2024, that the Rules of the House of Representatives 30 shall be amended by inserting a new part XIV to read as follows: 31 32
