1 WHEREAS, the average cost of full-time child care in Hawaii currently exceeds \$13,000 per year; and 2 3 WHEREAS, the rising cost of child care and lack of access 4 5 to adequate child care services prevents working parents from taking advantage of many social and economic opportunities, 6 including opportunities for civic engagement; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, strengthening public engagement is essential to ensuring that legislative outcomes reflect the needs of Hawaii's 10 residents and working families; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, the Legislature has adopted measures in recent years calling for the expansion of child care programs in public 14 15 places; and 16 17 WHEREAS, some legislative employees are also working parents in need of child care assistance; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, providing child care services at the Hawaii State 21 Capitol would empower working parents and caregivers to participate more fully in the legislative process; now, 22 therefore, 23 24 25 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 26 27 Session of 2024, that the Lieutenant Governor is requested to establish a working group to consider providing child care 28 29 services at the Hawaii State Capitol; and 30 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested 32 to:
