

## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII CLIMATE CHANGE MITIGATION AND ADAPTION COMMISSION TO DEVELOP VEHICLE MILES TRAVELED REDUCTION STRATEGIES AND MAKE RELATED RECOMMENDATIONS.

1 WHEREAS, decreasing transportation-related emissions is essential to achieving the State's greenhouse gas reduction 2 3 goals; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Climate Change Mitigation and Adaption Commission found that vehicle miles traveled is an important 6 measurement to track the State's efforts on greenhouse gas 7 reduction; and 8 9 WHEREAS, current strategies to mitigate vehicle miles 10 traveled in the State are ineffective; and 11 12 WHEREAS, vehicle miles traveled have increased almost forty 13 14 percent over the last twenty-five years and, without 15 intervention, are projected to continue to increase; now, therefore, 16 17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 18 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 19 20 Session of 2024, that the Hawaii Climate Change Mitigation and Adaption Commission is requested to: 21 22 (1) Develop vehicle miles traveled strategies; 23 24 25 (2) Recommend a statewide vehicle miles traveled reduction 26 target; 27 Recommend benchmarks for, and evaluate progress 28 (3) toward, the vehicle miles traveled reduction target; 29 30 and 31

1 (4) Identify state and county agencies to collaborate and 2 coordinate on the implementation of vehicle miles traveled reduction policies, strategies, and programs; 3 4 and 5 6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Climate Change 7 Mitigation and Adaption Commission is requested to submit a 8 report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than forty 9 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2025; and 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 12 Resolution be transmitted to the Co-Chairpersons of the Hawaii 13 Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation Commission. 14 15 16 OFFERED BY: MAR - 5 2024 17
