11 12	WHEREAS, law enforcement officers will likely investigate an increasing number of crimes relating to artificial

16	Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
17 18	Session of 2024, that the Director, Deputy Directors, and Administrators of the Department of Law Enforcement are urged to
19	undergo training on crimes relating to artificial intelligence
20 21	technology, including deepfakes and other related technologies, at least every two years; and
