HOUSE RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING THE IMPORTANCE OF USING PRONOUNS AND GENDER-AFFIRMING LANGUAGE.

WHEREAS, the use of gender-affirming language, such as 1 chosen names and pronouns, fosters an inclusive and equitable 2 environment, and signals respect; and 3 4 WHEREAS, gender-affirming language is associated with 5 better mental health outcomes including reduced depression and 6 7 suicide risk; and 8 WHEREAS, gender-affirming language supports one of our most 9 underrepresented communities; and 10 11 WHEREAS, gender-inclusive language recognizes and values 12 the diversity of our community, including diversity in gender 13 identity and expression, encompassing trans, non-binary, and 14 agender identities; and 15 16 WHEREAS, there are psychological, social, and cultural 17 implications associated with the usage of gender-affirming 18 language, recognizing diverse pronouns and identities across 19 different cultures; and 20 21 WHEREAS, there are also legal and policy considerations 22 regarding pronoun recognition in various contexts; and 23 24 WHEREAS, pronouns and gender-affirming language convey 25 vital aspects of identity and are fundamental to safety, 26 respect, inclusion, diversity, and care for others; now, 27 therefore, 28 29 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 30 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 31 Session of 2024, that this body recognizes the importance of 32 using pronouns and gender-affirming language; and 33 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 35 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, President of the 36
