HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT THE GOVERNOR ESTABLISH A LEADERSHIP ACCELERATOR PROGRAM FOR EXCEPTIONAL MANAGERS IN STATE GOVERNMENT.

1	WHEREAS, the Hawaii state government relies upon its
2 3	workforce of dedicated public employees to provide vital services that improve, strengthen, and protect communities
4	across the State; and

6	WHEREAS, public employees in managerial roles serve an
7	important function in overseeing the efficient delivery of these

10	WHEREAS, it is imperative for state government to recognize
11 12	and foster its managers as the leaders of Hawaii's future; and
12	WHEREAS, the Governor should assemble a cohort of managers
13 14	from state government who are rising leaders with exemplary
14	performance to receive specialized, regular leadership training;

18	BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
19	Thirty-second Legislature of State of Hawaii, Regular Session of
20	2024, that the Governor is requested to establish a leadership
21	accelerator program to:

23	(1) Acknowledge, train, and develop exceptional managers
24	in state government; and
25	
26	(2) Build relationships between such talented individuals
27	to break down silos and create channels of
28	communication between state departments; and
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30	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the program is requested to
31	include managers from each state department who are rising
32	leaders with exemplary performance, to be recommended by the
33	head of each department; provided that the total group size

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should not exceed forty participants; provided further that the 1 2 number of participants from each department shall be roughly 3 proportional to the size of the department, at the discretion of 4 the Governor; and 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the program is requested to 6 hold regularly scheduled leadership training meetings each 7 8 month; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the program is requested to submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including 11 any proposed legislation, to the Governor, Legislature, and each 12 department head no later than twenty days prior to the convening 13 of each regular session; and 14 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 16 17 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and each department head in the Executive Branch. 18 19 20 21 OFFERED BY:
