HOUSE RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING THE ISSUE OF ILLEGAL DUMPING WITHIN THE WAIPAHU COMMUNITY AND URGING THE STATE, CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU, AND MILITARY TO WORK TOGETHER TO ADDRESS THIS CONCERN.

WHEREAS, the act of illegal dumping poses significant, 1 environmental risks to the State's communities; and 2 3 WHEREAS, the disposal of waste materials in Waipahu 4 5 threatens public health and safety by contaminating soil, water sources, and roads; and 6 7 WHEREAS, illegal dumping has led to a hazardous environment 8 9 that affects Waipahu's natural habitat and residents in the 10 surrounding area; and 11 WHEREAS, illegal dumping has resulted in less pride for 12 cleanliness throughout the Waipahu community; and 13 14 15 WHEREAS, most neighboring residents do not fully acknowledge the same values to care for the Waipahu community, 16 17 which is creating an unhealthy environment for future 18 generations; now, therefore, 19 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 21 22 Session of 2024, that this body recognizes the issue of illegal dumping within the Waipahu community; and 23 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body urges the State, City and County of Honolulu, and military to work together to address 26 this concern; and 27 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this measure is intended to 30 bring awareness to the need for change to man-made, polluted areas within Waipahu; and 31

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2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Commander of Joint Base Pearl 3 Harbor-Hickam, Governor, Director of Transportation, Director of 4 5 Health, Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, and Director of the Department of Facility Maintenance of the City and County 6 7 of Honolulu. 8
