# HOUSE RESOLUTION

STRONGLY URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO RECONSIDER  
USING THE WAIPIŌ SOCCER COMPLEX AS ITS NEXT LANDFILL SITE.

1           WHEREAS, the Waipio Soccer Complex serves as a crucial hub  
2 for sports and recreational activities, providing opportunities  
3 for the community to engage in physical fitness and social  
4 interaction; and

5  
6           WHEREAS, the Waipio Soccer Complex is situated in a  
7 location of significant environmental importance, boasting  
8 diverse ecosystems and natural habitats that contribute to the  
9 ecological balance of the region; and

10  
11           WHEREAS, concerns have been raised regarding the City and  
12 County of Honolulu's proposal to convert the Waipio Soccer  
13 Complex into the next landfill site for the island of Oahu; and

14  
15           WHEREAS, since media coverage about the Waipio Soccer  
16 Complex's becoming a top choice as the site of the City and  
17 County of Honolulu's next landfill, residents from not only  
18 Waipahū but also other areas of Oahu have expressed strong  
19 concerns about losing the soccer park and locating a landfill  
20 near homes; and

21  
22           WHEREAS, the conversion of the Waipio Soccer Complex into a  
23 landfill site would pose detrimental effects on the environment,  
24 including soil contamination, air pollution, and disruption of  
25 wildlife habitats, including nearby marine and wetland habitats;  
26 and

27  
28           WHEREAS, the establishment of a landfill at the Waipio  
29 Soccer Complex would adversely affect the health and well-being  
30 of nearby residents, exposing them to potential hazards  
31 associated with waste-disposal activities, such as odors, noise,  
32 and increased traffic congestion; and



1 WHEREAS, Waipahu High School, which is located in close  
2 proximity to the Waipio Soccer Complex, would be significantly  
3 affected by the presence of a landfill, potentially exposing  
4 students, faculty, and staff to health risks and environmental  
5 hazards; and

6  
7 WHEREAS, there exist alternative sites for landfill  
8 development that are less ecologically sensitive and more  
9 suitable for accommodating waste-management needs without  
10 compromising the integrity of recreational spaces and natural  
11 environments; and

12  
13 WHEREAS, it is the duty of the City and County of Honolulu  
14 to prioritize the long-term sustainability and preservation of  
15 natural resources for the benefit of current and future  
16 generations of Oahu residents; now, therefore,

17  
18 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
19 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular  
20 Session of 2024, that the City and County of Honolulu is  
21 strongly urged to reconsider using the Waipio Soccer Complex as  
22 its next landfill site; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City and County of Honolulu  
25 is strongly encouraged to explore alternative solutions for  
26 waste management that do not involve the conversion of  
27 recreational and environmentally significant areas into landfill  
28 sites; and

29  
30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State of Hawaii is strongly  
31 urged to collaborate with the City and County of Honolulu and  
32 other relevant stakeholders in identifying and implementing  
33 sustainable waste-management practices that uphold environmental  
34 conservation, public health, and community well-being; and

36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
37 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Mayor of the City and  
38 County of Honolulu, and all members of the Honolulu City  
39 Council.
