HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT AN AUDIT OF CLEAN AND SOBER HOMES THAT ARE NOT REGISTERED UNDER THE CLEAN AND SOBER HOMES REGISTRY.

WHEREAS, clean and sober homes assist persons recovering 1 from substance abuse by providing a safe, clean, and sober 2 environment for rehabilitation; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the Department of Health's Alcohol and Drug Abuse 5 Division maintains the Clean and Sober Homes Registry; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the Clean and Sober Homes Registry provides a list 8 of clean and sober homes that meet certain quality management, 9 operational, and ethical standards; and 10 11 WHEREAS, an owner, operator, or landlord is prohibited from 12 holding a property out to be or advertise to be a "registered 13 clean and sober home" unless the home is registered and in good 14 standing with the Clean and Sober Homes Registry; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, the Department of Health is required to educate the public on clean and sober homes and the Clean and Sober 18 Homes Registry; and 19 20 WHEREAS, there have been reports of drug dealing and 21 22 illegal activities in unregistered clean and sober homes; and 23 WHEREAS, the act of drug dealing in clean and sober homes 24 25 undermines the very purpose of these homes and threatens the 26 rehabilitation process of persons recovering from substance abuse; and 27 28 WHEREAS, it is unknown how many unregistered clean and 29 sober homes are in operation; and 30 31



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WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the Auditor to
conduct an audit of unregistered clean and sober homes to
determine how many are not registered under the Clean and Sober
Homes Registry; now, therefore,

6 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 7 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 8 Session of 2024, that the Auditor is requested to conduct an 9 audit of the Department of Health's Clean and Sober Homes 10 Registry and any related programs; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 13 submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including a 14 list of unregistered clean and sober homes and any proposed 15 legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior 16 to the Regular Session of 2025; and

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this19 Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor and Director of Health.
