HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO WORK WITH THE UNITED STATES FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE TO IMPLEMENT A NATIVE PLANT SEEDING PROJECT IN MILILANI MAUKA TO RESTORE THE ECOLOGICAL DAMAGE FROM THE NOVEMBER 2023 WILDFIRES.

WHEREAS, plants native to Hawaii are essential to a 1 2 sustainable ecosystem because many are drought-tolerant and require less maintenance through fertilizing and pruning; and 3 4 WHEREAS, planting native species helps maintain and 5 preserve the critical biodiversity that makes Hawaii unique; and 6 7 WHEREAS, non-native grasses and shrubs are highly flammable 8 and perpetuate devastating wildfires; and 9 10 WHEREAS, non-native plants such as grasses and shrubs that 11 have been introduced into the island ecosystem are accustomed to 12 wildfires and easily reoccupy lands that have been recently 13 scorched by wildfires; and 14 15 WHEREAS, in November 2023, wildfires damaged 2.5 square 16 miles of the critical ecosystem in Mililani Mauka, including the 17 Oahu Forest National Wildlife Refuge and Koolau Mountains; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Mililani Mauka's impacted lands featured a native 20 forest of koa trees, uluhe fern, and twenty-two federally 21 designated endangered or threatened species that will be 22 23 vulnerable to invasive species takeover during ecosystem 24 recovery; now, therefore, 25 26 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 27 Session of 2024, that the Department of Land and Natural 28 Resources is urged to work with the United States Fish and 29 Wildlife Service to implement a native plant seeding project on 30 the lands impacted by the November 2023 wildfires in Mililani 31

Mauka to protect the area from the threat of similar devastation
in the future; and
