BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 37, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately	
3	designate	d and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§</u> 37	- Special funds; use for capital improvement
5	projects	authorized. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the
6	contrary,	an agency may expend moneys from special funds under
7	the agenc	y's control for capital improvement projects, even if
8	the expen	diture of moneys for capital improvement projects is
9	not expressly authorized by the special fund's enabling statute;	
10	provided	that:
11	(1)	Any expenditure on a capital improvement project shall
12		be subject to legislative appropriation or
13		authorization; and
14	(2)	Unless otherwise authorized by law, the agency shall
15		not expend moneys for capital improvement projects in
16		a fiscal year that exceeds twenty per cent of the
17		special fund's ceiling, if applicable.
