BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 4, First Special Session Laws of Hawaii 2 2021, is amended by amending section 1 to read as follows: 3 "SECTION 1. $\left[\frac{a}{a}\right]$ The department of health may require 4 the department of education [shall publish a weekly] to report on [schools that have a student, staff member, or affiliated 5 6 individual who has tested positive for coronavirus disease 2019 7 [(COVID 19). The report shall include: 8 (1) The school's name; 9 (2) The date the COVID-19 positive test result was 10 reported to the school; and (3) The date that the positively tested individual was 11 last on the school campus.] case counts and related information 12 13 in a manner most appropriate to public health and safety, as 14 determined by the department of health. 15 (b) The report shall be published weekly commencing after July 1, 2021, on the department of education's website.] " 16
