Section 302A-124, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending its title and subsection (a) to read as 2 3 follows: 4 "[+]\$302A-124[+] Board of education; [organization;] 5 election of chairperson and vice chairperson; quorum; meetings. 6 [The governor shall select a chairperson of the board; (a) 7 provided that the chairperson shall be selected from among the 8 at-large members.] The board shall elect, by simple majority of 9 members present, a chairperson from among its members. The 10 board shall [select] elect, by simple majority of members 11 present, a vice chairperson from among its members [, and the]. 12 The vice chairperson shall serve as interim chairperson in the event of the chairperson's absence or if the chairperson's seat 13 becomes vacant. The board may elect a chairperson annually upon 14 15 the start of the next confirmed term for members." 16 SECTION 3. Section 302A-125, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 17 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 18 "(b) Where the chairperson position becomes vacant, the 19 governor [may-nominate a-sitting member of the board to the 20 chairperson position in accordance with subsection -(a) - and] 21 shall fill any resulting vacancy in accordance with subsection

(a) [-] and subpart B of part I of this chapter; provided that,
upon filling the resulting vacancy, a new chairperson shall be
elected by the board pursuant to subsection 302A-124(a)."
SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Authorizes a majority of the members of the Board of Education to elect a chairperson from among the members of the Board. Allows the members to annually elect a chairperson upon the start of the next confirmed term for members. Removes the requirement that the chairperson be an at-large member.
