BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. No later than January 1, 2024, each county with
a population of 200,000 or less shall establish a five-year
pilot project to regulate the operation of hosting platforms
that provide booking services for transient accommodation
operators conducting business within those counties. For the
purposes of this Act:

7	(1)	"Booking service" means any reservation or payment
8		service provided by a person who facilitates a
9		transient accommodations transaction between a
10		prospective transient user and a host; and
11	(2)	"Hosting platform" means a person who participates in
12		the transient accommodations business by collecting or

16	SECT	ION 2. Each county with a population of 200,000 or
17	less shal	l submit a report of its findings and recommendations,

including any proposed legislation, regarding the regulation of
hosting platforms that provide booking services for transient
accommodation operators to the legislature no later than twenty
days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2029.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023, and6 shall repeal on June 30, 2029.
