A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 201H-122, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending the definition of "eligible project" to read 3 as follows: 4 ""Eligible project" means a rental housing project that: 5 Is financed by the corporation pursuant to subpart B (1)6 or D, or that the corporation determines will require 7 rental assistance to make it financially feasible; 8 (2) Is subject to a regulatory agreement with the 9 corporation; Maintains in perpetuity at least [twenty] fifty per 10 (3) cent of its units for eligible tenants; and 11 12 (4) Meets other qualifications as established by rules 13 adopted by the corporation. 14 Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, "eligible 15 project" may also include a rental housing project that is 16 financed by the corporation pursuant to subpart A."
