A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HAWAII STATE CONSTITUTION TO PROTECT INDIVIDUAL REPRODUCTIVE RIGHTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Article I of the Constitution of the State of
- 2 Hawaii is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "INDIVIDUAL REPRODUCTIVE RIGHTS
- 5 Section . No law shall be enacted that denies or
- 6 interferes with an individual's reproductive freedom in their
- 7 most intimate decisions, which includes their fundamental right
- 8 to choose to have an abortion and their fundamental right to
- 9 choose or refuse contraceptives."
- 10 SECTION 2. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
- 11 be as follows:
- 12 "Shall the Constitution be amended to state that no law
- shall be enacted that denies or interferes with an
- individual's reproductive freedom in their most intimate
- decisions, including the fundamental right to abortion and
- 16 contraceptives?"
