6	animals declaration form a statement substantially similar to
7	the following:
8	"Various federal, state, and county laws, rules, and
9	ordinances protect public monuments and structures, including
10	but not limited to Native Hawaiian cultural sites, burial
11	grounds, and places of worship. Learn more about these
12	protections at gohawaii.com/ .
13	I affirm that I am aware that protections may exist, and
14	that I will heed to Hawaii's desecration laws.""
15	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
